



Whitefriars Sailability Group 2014

Whitefriars Sailability Group is a RYA approved Foundation Sailability Group which operates as part of Whitefriars Sailing Club. Group members must be WSC members and follow all WSC rules.

New for 2014, the Whitefriars Sailing Club has introduced a concessionary single membership of £40 for sailors with disability who only attend and sail at the WSG sessions. Others who have their own boats and/or want to sail outside of the WSG sessions will have to pay the normal Club membership and berth fees. There is a Club joining fee of £30 for new members, however this may be waived at the discretion of the Club management committee.

Any Club member can apply for membership to the Group and their contribution will be much appreciated as it shows support for the Group. The WSG Membership fee for 2014 is £2 per person but if you wish to make any further contribution it would be appreciated as WSG operates on a tiny margin in order to ensure that Disabled Members do not have to pay more than able bodied members to participate in the sport of Sailing.

The aims of the Group is to provide facilities for disabled and less-able sailors and to promote their participation in the sailing community as a whole and in particular to provide development opportunities in both cruising and racing via sailing competitions.

WSG meeting minutes and accounts and other information about Sailability can be found on the Sailability notice board in the Club foyer. WSG is 'non profit making' and runs in a structured way, with clear operating procedures for all Sailability sessions. It needs volunteer helpers to support disabled and less-abled sailors on our regular Wednesday sessions during the summer months and on Sailability sessions at other times throughout the year.
