3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the clubhouse at Whitefriars SC

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the start hut (see map of lake)
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

7 CLASS FLAGS

RS300 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 3

9 COURSES

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be set around permanent and mobile racing marks. The diagrams in Addendum A show the position of the marks on the lake.
- 9.2 The courses to be sailed will be indicated by boards on the side of the committee signal vessel.

10 MARKS

Marks 0 - 9 will be solid yellow fixed buoys. Marks U,V,X,Y are movable yellow pillar buoys. The start marks will be red flags on buoys, the finish mark will be the start line.

11 OBSTRUCTIONS

Shallows are marked on the lake map in Addendum A. We have a 20 metre exclusion zone rule around the shore to respect anglers.
