# SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS To be read in conjunction with the RS Association Standard Sailing Instructions

# 3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the clubhouse at Whitefriars SC

# 5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the start hut (see map of lake)
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

# 7 CLASS FLAGS

RS300 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 3

# 9 COURSES

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be set around permanent and mobile racing marks. The diagrams in Addendum A show the position of the marks on the lake.
- 9.2 The course will be indicated by a number or letter identifying a mark. The background colour of the board shall indicate the required side (Green for a mark to be left to Starboard, Red for one to be left to Port).

The number of rounds will be indicated by a black numeral on a white background.

#### 10 MARKS

Marks 0 - 9 will be solid yellow fixed buoys. Marks U,V,X,Y are movable yellow pillar buoys. The start marks will be red flags on buoys.

#### 11 OBSTRUCTIONS

Shallows are marked on the lake map in Addendum A. We have a 20 metre exclusion zone rule around the shore to respect anglers.

#### 12 THE START

- 12.1 Races will be started using RRS 26 (5-4-1-0). For information only a bell will be sounded approximately 10 minutes before the Start.
- 12.2 The Start Line will be either:
  - a) the transit formed by the Start Hut Flag Pole bearing a Black and White Diamond and a moveable pole on the shoreline, also bearing a Black and White Diamond; or
  - b) The line between the mast of the committee boat displaying an orange flag and a fixed Club mark or Yellow Dan Buoy with a Red flag.
- 12.3 Inner and outer distance marks will be Yellow Dan Buoys with Red flags. If Inner and Outer Distance Marks are laid all boats shall pass between them when starting
- 12.4 An individual recall will be signalled by the appropriate Warning Flag being lowered to half-mast, together with one sound. This changes RRS 29.1.

#### 14 THE FINISH

- 14.1 The finishing line will be either:
  - a) the transit formed by the Start Hut Flag Pole bearing a Black and White Diamond and a moveable pole on the shoreline, also bearing a Black and White Diamond; or
  - b) The line between the mast of the committee boat displaying a blue flag and a fixed Club mark or Yellow Dan Buoy with a Red flag.
- 14.2 All boats shall pass between the Outer Distance Mark and the shore (or the ODM and the Committee Boat) to finish
