

Site maintenance/Grass cutting duty

Members who volunteer for the grass cutting duty are expected to cut the grass and do general tidying around the club. Please find areas that are in need of grass cutting or other clean up.

The Grass cutting duty is on Dutyman as a Monday. However, as this is quite weather dependent, it can be carried out on any day that week. This is an ideal duty for those who have a challenging or unpredictable work schedule.

The expectation is that you should do about four hours of grass cutting/maintenance/tidying in the week so that it is comparable with other club duties.

The lawnmower and strimmer are kept under the start hut which is accessed using the same padlock code as the clubhouse.

Fuel for the machines is kept in the red fuel store by the start hut and the key is on the start hut key ring which is on a large colourful fob under the hot water dispenser in the clubhouse. The mower uses regular fuel as used in the powerboats. The strimmer uses 2 stroke fuel which is in a clearly marked can in the fuel store.
